On May 6, 2020, the U.S. Department of Education published the long-anticipated final Title IX regulations, which take effect on August 14, 2020, amidst the national emergency caused by the current COVID-19 pandemic. The final regulations significantly reshape the responsibilities of colleges and universities under Title IX and the process institutions must follow when investigating and adjudicating Title IX complaints, including a requirement that institutions conduct live hearings with cross examination and provide advisors to parties without one to conduct cross examination at no cost.
